**Speaking Assessment: Interview Tasks**

**INTERVIEWER**

**Part 1**

Hello, please come in and take a seat. How are you doing today?

Thank you. My name is [interviewer's name]. Can you tell me your first and last name?

So, why are you taking this English class?

What is your favorite part of the class?

I'm going to ask you to talk a little about some your skills.

What kinds of special skills do you have?

What job or jobs do you think would give you a chance to use your skills?

**Part 2**

I'm going to give you a card. The card has a topic on it. You have one minute to make notes. Then you should talk about the topic for two minutes. Do you understand?

[Instructor: make copies of card on page 3 and show student.]

Talk about a goal you have for the future.

You should say:

- What kinds of things you need to do to reach that goal
- What kinds of skills can help you
- How easy or difficult it will be to reach the goal

And make a prediction about what will happen as you try to reach your goal.

### Part 3

Very good. Let's talk about some of your values and beliefs now.

*Suggested interview questions:*

- What three values are most important to you, and why?
- What are the most important qualities a friend should have?
- How often do you visit friends in their home?
- What are some polite things to do when going to someone's home for dinner?
- What would you do if you forgot a friend's birthday? Has this ever happened to you?
- Say a proverb you know. What do you think it means?
- What are two things that are not allowed in a museum?
- Do you believe in any superstitions? Explain.
- What do you hope to do in the future?

Very good. We are almost at the end of the interview.

Do you want to tell me about anything else?

OK, then. Goodbye, and thank you for talking with me.

Talk about a goal you have for the future.

You should say:

- What kinds of things you need to do to reach that goal
- What kinds of skills can help you
- How easy or difficult it will be to reach the goal

And make a prediction about what will happen as you try to reach your goal.
