Speaking Assessment: Read a text aloud

Questions 1–2: Read a text aloud

Directions: Read aloud the text below. You will have 45 seconds to prepare. Then you will have 45 seconds to read aloud.

I used to have a terrible fear of public speaking. Whenever I had to give a presentation in school, I always got really stressed out about it. Sometimes I even felt sick and couldn't go to school that day. Now I have a job in an advertising company, and public speaking is part of my regular work routine. I still get nervous before speaking to a crowd sometimes, but I've found that it's helpful to try some relaxation techniques, like meditation. A friend of mine also suggested that I join a club that helps people with their public speaking skills. So I did! Every month we have to prepare a different kind of presentation. Sometimes I think I never should have signed up for the class because it stresses me out, but I think it's actually helping.

Questions 3–5: Answering questions

Directions: You will hear and answer three questions. For each question, begin answering after you hear a beep. No time is given for preparation. You have 15 seconds to answer Questions 3 and 4, and 30 seconds to respond to Question 5.

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Questions 6–8: Answering questions about a list of hotel services

Directions: In this part of the test, you will answer three questions based on a flight information board. You have 30 seconds to read the information before the questions start. For each question, begin answering after you hear a beep. No other time is given for preparation. You have 15 seconds to answer Questions 6 and 7, and 30 seconds to answer Question 8.
