When they finished looking around, they went into the observation room and watched an amazing film about stars and planets.

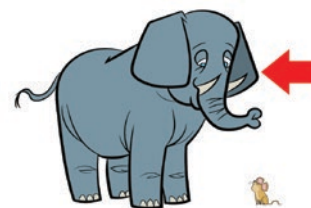

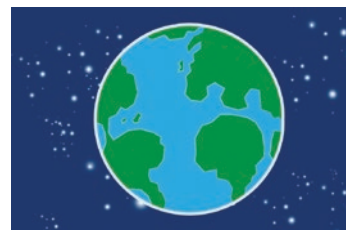
