We all know about climate change. We know that there is too much plastic in our oceans. We know that pollution from planes and wasting food are human activities that damage the environment. Doing things like drying washing outside, eating non-meat products and walking or cycling to school can help. But there is another big difference we can make – we can try to make better choices about the things we wear and where we get them from.

Fast fashion is a problem. We all want to look good and keep up with key trends in fashion, and in many high street stores we are able to buy cheap, new clothes that are fashionable. Styles change all the time, and customers can shop cheaply and replace their 'old' clothes for the latest trends.

Factories can produce new clothes very quickly and cheaply, but their quality isn't always very good. The result of this is that we produce a lot of waste that we don't recycle and it often pollutes our environment. We throw away more than half of our clothes.

But there's another problem, too. Fast fashion wastes far too much water. For example, it takes around 7,600 litres of water to make just one pair of jeans. Also, many factories use different chemicals and plastic to help produce the clothes more cheaply. Then when we wash our clothes,

these materials enter the water system and eventually cause harm to wildlife. Our fashion choices come with a price.

So what can we do? We need to start thinking more carefully about what we buy and how often we go shopping. It's better to spend a little bit more money on better quality materials and then keep those clothes for longer. The clothes we buy should also be more friendly for the planet, for example, they should contain natural materials instead of plastic. Finally, we should also stop trying to keep up to date with the latest fashion trends. We can try to be more creative with the clothes we already own. It's time for change. It's time to say goodbye to fast fashion.
