 - Say hello to Student B and say you are looking forward to the party.
 - Tell Student B an idea you have for the party: everybody wears costumes.
 - Clarify for Student B that you are thinking about superhero costumes.
 - Respond to Student A politely that they can invite anyone he/she likes to the party.
