GAME SHOWS

Game shows are very popular television programmes. One famous British show is *Who wants to be a Millionaire?* On the show, people answer questions. The questions are easy at first, but they become more difficult. Between 1998 and 2008, fifteen players won the top prize of £1,000,000! People also played this show in many different countries, such as the USA, South Africa and Japan.

The first ever TV game show was in 1938. It was a British show called *Spelling Bee*. The presenter was a man called Freddie Grisewood. He had short, dark hair and glasses. Freddie asked people on the show to spell words. The show wasn't very exciting because the game was really easy!

But her music became very popular! Noemi is slim, with long, brown hair. She first appeared on TV when she was a baby!
