Travelling in the city

This city is very big so there are lots of ways you can travel around. We have taxis, a metro, trains, buses and boats. There is also a large international airport.

When you arrive at the airport you should take the metro into the city centre. There is a special airport service and it takes just 15 minutes. Also, it's a 24-hour service. The tickets are more expensive, but it's much quicker than the other metro lines.

The city centre has lots of hotels, restaurants and museums. It is popular with tourists. There is also a special tourist bus which visits all the interesting places. It costs £25 but you can use the bus many times in one day. Tickets for children are only £8.

Most people live outside the city centre because it's cheaper. The north part of the city by the river is a popular place for students to live. Most people take the train into the city centre because it's faster than the metro. The business area is in the south of the city and it has a lot of office buildings. Many people like driving to work so there is always a lot of traffic there. This area has got a lot of car parks so it's easier to park there than in other parts of the city.

The east part of the city is by the sea. There are lots of ships and boats there. Most of them are for business, but there is also a ferry service to an island. Only 200 people live on the island and the only way to travel there is by ferry. The ferry leaves at 8.00 a.m. and returns at 8.00 p.m.
