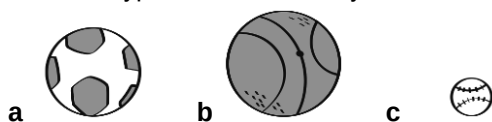

1 The Olympics

• The first modern Olympics was in Greece in 1896. There were no women, only men. In the 2012 Olympics in London, there were women from every country.

• In the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing, China, the swimmer Michael Phelps won eight gold medals. He has the most Olympic medals – twenty-eight, and twenty-three of them are gold!

2 Football players

• 'Football' or 'soccer'? In the USA they play 'American football', and in Canada they play 'Canadian football'. But these sports aren't the same as the game we see in the FIFA World Cup. In the USA and Canada, they call this game 'soccer'. The word 'soccer' came from England, but now the English say 'football'.

• Football players often run about eleven kilometres in a match – six more than tennis players and seven more than basketball players.

3 Tennis

• There were yellow tennis balls for the first time in 1972. It's easier to see yellow balls than white balls on colour TV. Players started using yellow balls at the famous Wimbledon tennis tournament in 1986.

• In 1995, Chanda Rubin and Patricia Hy-Boulais played for three hours and forty-five minutes – the longest women's match at Wimbledon. But John Isner and Nicolas Mahut played for eleven hours and five minutes – also at Wimbledon, in June 2010. This was the longest match ever.
