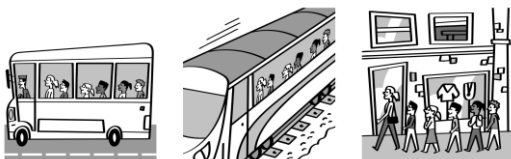

How to study like a pro

Got an important exam coming up? Finding it difficult to start revising? Then use my top study tips to help you!

First, when possible, avoid all things which might stop you studying. ⁰ b I told everyone I was studying then and so not to call, message or email me. That gave me time to focus on the unit of the subject I was studying and nothing else.

Another important technique I used was to make notes by hand. The results of one study said that this helps you learn better as it makes you think carefully about the subject. ¹ _____ It's important not to hurry!

Personally, I'm more hard-working in silence. But some people find listening to music helps them revise. My friend Abbie told me that she listens to slow music and it helps her focus. ² _____

Research shows that a few days after learning something, we can forget up to half the information. ³ _____ You only need to look over your notes for a few minutes. But this means you won't have to learn everything from the beginning again later! When you're starting your study time, begin with subjects you feel more confident in.

⁴ _____ Also, it'll help you feel more confident in order to work on the subjects you think are more difficult.

Finally, find a 'study buddy' – someone who you can study with. ⁵ _____ And even if you're not, it will help you keep to a schedule and motivate you both to work.
